# How the Care Act helps to keep you safe



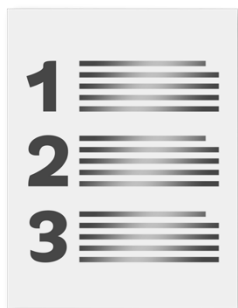
An easy read leaflet about The Care Act



The Care Act says it is now the law to keep people safe. This is called **Safeguarding**.



Every local council needs to have a **Safeguarding Adults Board**.



The Safeguarding Adults Board must meet regularly and **make plans** to keep people safe.



The Safeguarding Adults Board must deal with any **safeguarding issues**.



The Care Act says that different organisations should **work together** to keep people safe.



This means people like the Police, the Council and the NHS.
