8. Someone who can use a computer.
9. Someone who is good at working in an office and who can keep information in the right order and follow the rules.
10. A person who is on time for things and can manage their diary.
11. A person who is clean and tidy.
12. Someone who has the Advocacy Qualification or is willing to work towards it.
