This post is sessional and you will need to be able to be flexible with your availability across the working week. You will be providing one to one advocacy to adults and young people with a learning disability. This work will include one to one advocacy for parents with a learning disability during Child in Need, Child Protection and Care Proceedings.

Advocacy in Greenwich wants everyone to have rights and choices; to be able to say what they want and to be heard and to be part of the community. We will work together with people with learning disabilities and young people to change the way that people think to make this happen.

We offer self - advocacy and one to one advocacy to people with learning disabilities and young people with disabilities in the Royal Borough of Greenwich. This is provided by paid staff to ensure that people listen to the views and wishes of the individuals they support, respect their rights and that people have control over their own destinies.

We have recently achieved the Advocacy Quality Performance Mark for the third time. This is an opportunity to join an organisation providing high quality advocacy services.
